What are some of the best experiences of worship that you can remember? I am thinking about worship-in-song with an organ, guitar, piano, or just voices. This could be at church, a conference, or anywhere.

I recall being with my dad in 1997 at 'Stand in the Gap', a solemn assembly of men put on by *Promise Keepers* in Washington DC. The thousands of men worshipping God in one voice moved me deeply, even as a wayward teenager at that time.

I remember in 1998 the first time I lifted my hands in worship. I can vividly remember the people I was with and the aqua/white collared shirt I was wearing. This was a big deal for me because I had a "cool guy" image that was seriously jeopardized by my "all-in" gesture of worship that day.

I recall in 1999 when the Passion Worship Band came to Florida State's campus and led worship in a big auditorium on campus. This was powerful because it was the first time I had heard worship in my own musical "heart language" (i.e. contemporary).

# I love to worship.

Most of my life as a Christian is lived out with my brothers and sisters in Christ in my local church. I want us to be the worshipping church that God wants us to be. I want the worship to be God-honoring, Christ-exalting, and amazing at the church I raise my kids in and at the church I invite my friends and neighbors to.
